The following Deed of Conveyance from William Roe to John Taden being proven before B Blackwell Esq<sup>r</sup>. by the oath of John Harrison was presented & recorded this 21<sup>st</sup> day of Aug. 1795

This I M A M W L made the thirteenth day of November in the year of Lord one thousand seven hundred & ninety four in the twenty year of the sovereignty & independance of the united states of America between William Roe of Greenville County & state of South Carolina of the one part & John Taden of Greenville County of the other part & it is all aforesaid Witnesseth that for & in consideration of fifty five pounds Sterling in hand paid to the s<sup>r</sup>. William Roe by the s<sup>r</sup>. John Taden before the sealing & delivery ~~hereof~~ the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged the aforesaid William Roe hath purely bargained sold conveyed unto the before mentioned John Taden a certain Tract of Land containing one hundred & one Acre situate in Greenville County on a branch of Reedy River being part of a Tract of Land granted to Joseph Nason the sixth of February Anno domini one thousand seven hundred eighty six this Excellency William Moutree Esq<sup>r</sup>. containing two hundred & fifty one Ares butting & bounding on land belonging to James Coon beginning on a Spanish oak called a black oak South 30 Ea 96. to post oak thence S 70 E. 306. to a hickory thence N 20 E 426. to a Stake on the lower line on the beaverdam thence to the beginning with all & singular the woods waters profits Commodities ~~and~~ appurtenances unto the s<sup>r</sup>. John Taden his heirs & assigns forever & the s<sup>r</sup>. William Roe for his
