 Edwards being proven before John Thomas Jun^r Esq^r. by the oath
 of Paul Abner was presented & recorded this 22nd Day of Aug. 1795
 This Indenture made this Day of August one thousand seven
 hundred & Ninety five in the eighteenth year of the American Inde-
 pendence Between Eli Norman of the State of South Ca-
 rolina Greenville County, of the one part, & Joseph Edwards
 of the s^d. State & County of the other part Witnesseth that
 the s^d. Eli Norman for & in Consideration of the sum of
 forty pounds in hand p^d. hath bargain'd & sold unto the s^d.
 Joseph Edwards a plantation or tract of Land contain-
 ing two hundred & ninety Nine Acres lying & being in
 Greenville County on the waters of Enore & on the north
 side of Brushy Creek bounded on the south by
