The following Deed of Conveyance from James Seaborn to Charles  
 Pope being proven before Helgore Esq<sup>r</sup> by the oath of John Thomas  
 Jun<sup>r</sup> was presented & recorded this 24<sup>th</sup> Day of August A 1795  
 This M<sup>ts</sup> made this thirteenth Day of October in the  
 year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred & Ninety four and in the  
 eighteenth year of the Independence of America between James  
 Seaborn of the State of S<sup>c</sup> Carolina & C<sup>t</sup>y of Greenville of the one  
 part, & Charles Pope of the s<sup>d</sup>. State & C<sup>t</sup>y of the other part, & it is  
 c<sup>on</sup> - J<sup>es</sup>eth that the s<sup>d</sup>. James Seaborn for & in consideration of the sum  
 of fifty pounds to him in hand paid by the s<sup>d</sup>. Charles Pope at & before  
 the sealing & delivery of these presents the Receipt whereof the s<sup>d</sup>. James  
 Seaborn doth hereby acknowledge, doth & from every part & parcel thereof  
 do acquit & discharge the s<sup>d</sup>. Charles Pope his heirs & assigns, have granted  
 bargained sold & confirmed & by these presents doth Grant bargain sell  
 alien Enfranch<sup>is</sup> & confirm unto him the s<sup>d</sup>. Charles Pope his heirs & assigns  
 forever, all that plantation or tract of one hundred acres of Land be-  
 the same more or <sup>be it</sup> less, originally granted to the s<sup>d</sup>. James Seaborn  
 & signed by his Excellency Thomas Pinckney the fifth Day of Janua-  
 ry in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred & eighty nine  
 Situate in Greenville C<sup>t</sup>y on both sides of Stony Creek, bounded on  
 the s<sup>d</sup>. West, on the s<sup>d</sup>. East, & on the North East sides on Thomas  
 Lons Land & on the North west on vacant Land, being laid out  
 unto the s<sup>d</sup>. Charles Pope as follows, beginning on a black oak corner  
 & South 30 E 44 C. to a stake corner from thence running N
