

 John Harrison being proven before J. B. Blackwell Esq. by the
 oath of John Paden was presented & recorded this 25th Day of Aug 1795
 This Indenture made this twentieth day of November
 in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred & ninety four and
 in the twentieth year of the sovereignty & independence of the united States
 States of America between John Goodman of Greenville County & State
 of S. Carolina of the one part & John Harrison of Greenville County
 of the other part & State aforesaid Witnesseth that for & in Conside-
 ration of fifty five Pounds Sterling in hand Paid to the s^d. John
 Goodman by the s^d. John Harrison before the reading & signing
 hereof the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged ~~by~~ John
 Goodman hath hereby bargained sold & conveyed unto the before
 mentioned John Harrison & certain Tract of Land contain-
 ing one hundred & fifty Acres situate in Greenville County on
 Paddy River being part of a Tract of Land granted to Joseph
 Nelson on the sixth Day of February anno Domini one tho-
 usand seven hundred & ninety six by His Excellency William
 Moultrie Esq. Containing two hundred & fifty one Acres butting
 & bounding beginning at a red oak on James Coons Line thence
 S 60 W 2 qrs a black oak thence N 39 E 31 on William
 Bensons line to a black oak thence N 30 thence N 44 W 56
 50 to the beginning Together with all & singular the Woods
