


And eighteen acres surveyed for him the thirtieth Day of October one thousand

 Claim or Claims of any person or persons whatsoever & She the said Nancy Gil  
 breath both for herself her heirs & assigns all or either of them & every person  
 or persons warrant & forever defend the above one hundred acres of Land be the  
 same more or less with all its appertinances unto him the said Jacob Heaters his  
 heirs & assigns & every of them in witness whereof & the said Nancy Gilbreath  
 have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal the day & year first above writen

 The following Deed of conveyance from John Huddleston to Willey &  
 Brown being proven before William Anderson Esq. by the oath of  
 Nimrod Maxwell was presented & recorded this 27<sup>th</sup> January 1796

This Indenture made and concluded on the third day of November  
 in the year of our Lord one thousand Seven hundred & ninety five & twen tyeth  
 year of Americas Independence between John Huddleston of Greenville County  
 South Carolina of the one part and Willey & Brown of the county & State aforesaid  
 of the other witnesseth that for & in consideration of the sum of thirty pounds  
 Sterling Money to him in hand paid the receipt and payment whereof is  
 hereby acknowledged by the said Huddleston & John Huddleston a plantation  
 or tract of land containing Seven five Acres be the same more or less being a  
 part of a tract of three hundred & twenty six acres granted by patent bearing  
 date the fifth of December one thousand seven hundred & ninety one unto  
 Joseph Maxwell & by him conveyed to the said Huddleston lying and  
 being in the county and State aforesaid on Greens Creek of S<sup>o</sup> Carolina  
 Beginning at a red oak in the fork of said Creek & runs about one chain  
 from the river and running thence N. 37 1/2 chains to a red oak thence  
 N 25 1/2 chain to a red oak thence N 37 1/2 chain to a white oak thence  
 N 10 E 16 chain crossing the creek to a black oak sapling on a corner  
 thence S 60 E 16 chain 50 links to a white oak thence S 70 E 9 chain  
 50 links to a pine thence S 70 W 11 chain 80 links to S<sup>o</sup> bounded corner a  
 Stake thence S. 17 W to the Beginning crossing S<sup>o</sup> Greens Creek nowidge that  
 I the aforesaid John Huddleston for my self my heirs executors  
 admors & every of them do hereby warrant and for ever defend unto the said  
 Willey & Brown his heirs executors admors & assigns to have and to  
 hold the aforesaid tract of seven five acres of land with all &
