


New Indenture made this thirteenth day of April in the year of our Lord a thousand
 thousand seven hundred & ninety five & in the nineteenth year of the independence of the united
 States of America between John Duncan of the county of Greenville & State of South Carolina
 of the first part & Moses Blewett late of the State of North Carolina & Count of Surrey of
 the second part witnesses that the S^r John Duncan hath for & in consideration of the sum
 of fifty pounds Sterling money to him in hand paid on the sealing & acknowledging these
 presents the receipt of which I hereby witnesseth hath bargained & sold & by these presents doth
 bargain & sell unto the S^r Moses Blewett his heirs & assigns a certain plantation or tract
 of land containing one hundred & seventy nine acres or thereabouts in the same more or less lying in Green
 -ville County on the north fork of Deep creek a branch of Saluda river & purchased by the S^r
 Duncan of John Evans the courses & boundaries of which are as follows beginning on the long
 line in a bottom & running from thence N^o East on Perry woods line to a black oak tree
 thence N^o 19 poles to a post oak from thence N^o 20 degrees to a chain to a Spanish oak from
 thence N^o W 55 degrees to the dividing Ridge path between William Bellingsley &
 this land and from thence along the S^r path to the beginning with all houses or other
 & every other emolument to the S^r Land and premises belonging to have & to
 hold ^{all} singular the aforesaid land & premises unto the S^r Moses Blewett his heirs
 & assigns forever full complete & that his at the time & conveying the aforesaid land
 possessed of at good & lawful right & title thereof to himself & the S^r John Duncan
 both here by warrant & forever defend the right of the aforesaid land to the S^r Moses Blewett
 & to his heirs & assigns forever as aforesaid against the claim or claims of all & every
 other person or persons that may at any time hereafter set up any title or claim to
 the same or any part thereof or witnesseth of the said John Duncan that he
 -writs out his hand & Seal the day & year first above written Signed sealed & m
 acknowledged in presence of

The following Bill of Sale from Rich^d Tankersley to Rowland Tankersley
 being proved before Reuben Barrett Esq^r by the Oath of John Rodgers
 was presented & recorded this 28th day of January A^d 1796.

I now all men by these presents that I Richard Tankersley of the State of
 Carolina & County of Greenville for & in consideration of the sum of three hundred
 pounds Sterling to me in hand paid at and before the sealing & delivery
 of these presents have bargained sold & delivered unto my son Rowland
 Tankersley one Negro man named Dick about forty six years old one Negro
 woman named Lucy forty years old one Negro boy named Sam twelve years
 old one Negro girl named Agnes one I^o named Rex one Negro boy named
 Belfast one Negro named Gatenah all of the above named Lucy one
 Negro woman named Phoebe one Subal Guiding fifteen years old
 100 two feather beds & furniture together with all other household
 furniture of every kind whatsoever which I do by these presents
