This Indenture made the Twelfth day of March one thousand seven hundred and ninety five witnesseth that Robert Smith of the State of South Carolina and County of Greenville of the one part And Alexander Stevenson of the County of Spartan & State aforesaid of the other part witnesseth that for and in consideration of the sum of ten pounds Sterling Money to the said Robert Smith by the said Alexander Stevenson at or before the Sealing & delivering of these presents the receipt whereof I hereby acknowledge and therefore do release acquit and discharge the said Alexander Stevenson his heirs & Adm<sup>rs</sup> by these presents do grant bargain & sell estimate and confirm to the S<sup>r</sup>. Alexander Stevenson his heirs or assigns forever three hundred & forty four acres of land lying & being in the State above S<sup>c</sup>. County of Greenville on both sides of Steek branch and hath such marks as is represented in the above plat all houses buildings orchards way water & water courses profits commodities hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever thereunto belonging to the S<sup>r</sup>. premises hereby granted or any part thereof belonging or in any way pertaining also all the estate right Title Interest use Trust property claim or
