


present wife Frankey the said Negroes & their Increase as aforesaid then to be equally divided so near as may be between all my children that may be then living which I may have by my present wife Frankey but nevertheless I do make this reserve in this gift & conveyance, to control the force thereof from being in full Effect, that if either of my children should Marry before my decease I am then thereby have the free privilege of giving such child or children at their Marriage such part ~~such part~~ of said Negroes as I shall see cause the then said Gift does not make an equal proportion of a dividend at that time, & the ballance of the Negroes that is not divided among the Children during the life of Elias Earle, are then to be equally divided among the Children that has not rec^d their part of said Negroes, thereof.  Washington County } This Indenture made this twenty second day of February one thousand seven hundred and ninety three Between Arthur Bennet of the County & State aforesaid of the one part & William Powell Riddell of the County of Newberry & State of South Carolina of the other part witnesseth that for and in consideration of the sum of fifty pounds Sterling to him the said Arthur Bennet in hand well & Truly paid by the said Riddell at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents the Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath Granted bargained & sold by these presents doth bargain & sell unto the said William Powell Riddell all that plantation or tract of land containing two hundred acres more or less lying and being in the County of Greenville in the State of South Carolina on a Branch of Reedy River Originally Granted unto the said Arthur Bennet Putting & bounding S.E. by Youngs land, N. by Muckles land & Nations all other sides by vacant land to have & to hold the said Tract or parcel of land unto the said William Powell Riddell his heirs & assigns against the Claim or claims of me my heirs and assigns or any other person or persons claiming any Right or Title thereto In Witness whereof the
