The following Deed of Conveyance from Samuel Crafford to John White being
proven before Amb. Blackburn Esq. by the oath of Nichols Cooper was
presented and Recorded this 23rd day of April A.D. 1796

This Indenture made this sixteenth day of January in the year of our Lord
one thousand seven hundred and ninety six between Samuel Crafford of the
State of South Carolina County of Greenville of the one part, & John White of
said State & County of the other part Witnesseth that the said Samuel for in
consideration of the sum of one hundred and seventy pounds Currant mon-
ey of said State to him in hand well & truly paid at & before the sealing & delivery
of these presents the receipt whereof he doth hereby acknowledge hath & doth lawfully
bargain sell and convey unto the said John White his heirs and assigns for
ever all that parcel or part of Land containing two hundred & seventy acres
granted to said Samuel Crafford by his Excellency William Moultrie Esq. Govern-
or on the first day of January one thousand seven hundred & eighty seven
as appears from a Grant Recorded in Book 2222 page 45th beginning at a
state corner near the Golden Grove Creek running thence N 45 E 16-00 to a
post oak, thence S 45 W 10-00 to a stake corner, thence S 45 E 22-50 to a red oak
corner, thence N 45 E 5-50 to a black oak corner, thence S 45 E 20-50 to a
spanish oak corner, thence N 45 E 67-00 to a stake corner, thence N 45 W
30-00 to a Stake corner, thence S 45 W 56-00 to a post oak corner, thence N 45 W
56-00 to a stake corner, thence S 45 W 8-00 to a stake corner, thence N 45 W 7-50 to a
stake corner thence S 45 W 5-50 to the beginning. State Corner bounded North by
