The following Deed of Conveyance from William Poree to John Layman being proven before John Alexander Esquire by the oath of George French was presented and recorded this 11th day of August 1796

South Carolina this Indenture made this fifth day of April one thousand seven hundred and ninety two between William Poree of the State of South Carolina and Greenville County of the one part & John Layman of said State & County of the other part witnesseth that the s^d William Poree for and in consideration of the sum of eighty pounds lawful sterling money to him in hand well & truly paid at and before the sealing & delivery of these presents, the receipt thereof is hereby acknowledged hath given granted bargained sold aliened released and confirmed, and by these presents doth grant bargain sell alien release and confirm unto the said John Layman him his heirs and assigns for ever all that part of a certain Tract of land Originally granted to Miles Inmings for 1823 acres & signed on the 5th April 1786 by William M^ontathie Esq^r then Governor of S^c Carolina and lying in Greenville County on Mountain Creek the waters of Saluda River all that part of s^d Tract beginning on a small post oak in a part of a road thence s⁶ 32° 13 chains to a pine corner on said Road, thence W 76° 22 chains to a large Red oak thence S 44° 22 chains fifty links to a stone corner on the Original line thence on the said line to Blackwells line, thence N. E. 25° 12 chains to post oak corner Blackwells corner from thence to the beginning containing one hundred and eight acres be the same more or less, Together with all & singular the Trees waters hereditaments rights members & appurtenances whatsoever to the s^d Tract of land & premises hereby bargained & sold belonging or in any wise appertaining and the reversion and Reversions, remainder and remainders rents Issues and profits thereof to have and to hold the said Tract or parcel of land and premises hereby bargained & sold with their and every of their appurtenances unto the said John Layman his heirs and assigns to his and their only proper use and behoof absolutely & for ever and lastly the said William Poree doth for himself and his heirs the above described Tract of land unto the said John Layman him his heirs & assigns against all and every person or persons shall and will warrant and for ever defend In witness thereof the s^d William Poree doth hereunto set his hand and seal this day and year first above written Viz. the 5th April 1792
