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The following Deed of Conveyance from David Hall to Robert Goodgion being proved before Baylis Earle Esq^r by the oath of Ruf^{us} Huddleston was presented and recorded this 13th day of January A^d 1797
 This Indenture made this eighteenth day of Octob^r in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred & ninety four & in the nineteenth year of the Independance of the united States of America between David Hall of the State of South Carolina and county of Greenville of the one part and Robert Goodgion of the same place affores^d of the other part witnesseth that the s^d Hall for & in consideration of the sum of five pounds Sterling money to him in hand ~~paid~~ by the said Goodgion before the sealing & delivery of these presents the receipt whereof the said Hall doth hereby acknowledge have given granted bargained & sold & by these presents do give grant bargain and sell unto Robert Goodgion apart of a tract of land of three hundred and eighty four acres lying & being in the County & State aforesaid on the waters of s^d Pacolale River which part contains two hundred and twenty four acres of land be it more or less beginning at a cypress corner running N 75 E 20 c to a post oak thence S 30 E 11 c 50 l to a red oak thence E 11 c to a black oak thence N 60 E 34 c 50 l to a stake thence W 15 E 16 c 50 l to a stake on s^d States line, on the waggon Road, thence along said Road to a P.O. thence N 30 W 2 c 50 l to a hickory, thence S 75 W 10 c to a chestnut, thence N 55 W 79 c 50 l to a chestnut on s^d Goodgion land, thence a straight line to the beginning corner it being apart of the aforesaid tract of land that was granted to the aforesaid ^{David} Hall by his Excellency William Moultrie Governor of the aforesaid State the first day of July one thousand seven hundred and ninety three which part may more fully appear by a plat therunto annexed Together with all houses woods gardens ways waters commodities hereditaments
