The following deed of conveyance from Young Griffin to Robert Benson being proven before John Blackwell Esq<sup>r</sup> by the oath of Prue Benson was presented and recorded this 11<sup>th</sup> day of April 1797

This Indenture made this thirtieth day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety six between Young Griffin of Greenville County of the one part & Robert Benson of the aforesaid County of the other part witnesseth that the said Young Griffin for and in consideration of the sum of fifty pounds to him in hand paid by the said Robert Benson the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged granted bargained & sold & by these presents doth grant bargain & sell unto the said Robert Benson his heirs and assigns for ever a certain tract of land containing one hundred and ninety acres be the same more or less in the State of South Carolina Greenville County on both sides of Enoree River and bounded as follows (Viz) beginning at a stake thence S 10 E 56 chains to a pine corner thence S 65 W 35 chains to a stake corner thence N 10 W 56 chains to a pal oak corner thence N 65 E 35 chains to the beginning it being a tract of land laid out for William & James Tubb granted by Robert Pierce together with all waters woods profits commodities hereditaments appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining to him & he hold the said tract of land hereby granted & sold with these & every of their appurtenances unto the said Robert Benson his heirs & assigns for ever & the s<sup>r</sup> Young Griffin for himself his heirs Executors Administrators & assigns doth warrant the said bargained premises with their appurtenances unto the s<sup>r</sup> Benson his heirs and assigns against the claim or claims of every other person or persons whatsoever shall and will warrant & for defend by these presents In witness whereof the said Young Griffin hath hereunto set his hand and seal the day and year above written
