The following deed of Conveyance from Wm Wilson & Patty Wilson to John White  
 being proven before Amb. Blackburn Esq. by the oath of Davis Moon was presented &  
 Recorded this 18<sup>th</sup> day of April A.D. 1797

This Indenture made this twenty third day of July in the year of our Lord one thou-  
 sand seven hundred and ninety six between William & Patty Wilson of the State of  
 South Carolina & County of Greenville of the one part & John White of the State  
 & County of the other part, witnesseth that William & Patty for the full consideration  
 of twenty pounds lawful Money to them in hand well & truly paid by said John at &  
 before the sealing & delivery of these presents the receipt whereof they doth hereby  
 acknowledge hath and do hereby bargain sell and deliver unto said John his heirs &  
 assigns forever all that parcel or tract of land containing thirty acres more or less  
 being part of a Tract of one hundred acres Originally surveyed for Samuel  
 Ware and granted to him the fifth day of June 1786 beginning at a red oak  
 corner (now made) upon the line between said Wilson & Sarah Charles origi-  
 nally surveyed for John Ware, thence about a south E. Course along a line  
 promiscuously marked to a beech corner (now made) on W. Charles Spring  
 branch, thence up the longest prong of said Branch to a poplar Station on  
 a line between said Wilson & Samuel Crafford, thence along said line to a red  
 corner, where said Wilsons line intersects it, and thence along said line  
 to the beginning red oak corner to have and to hold said granted premis-  
 es together with all and singular the appurtenances thereunto in any  
 wise or of any kind belonging to the said John his heirs and assigns  
 for the true & punctual performance of which we hereby bind ourselves his or  
 assigns and every other person or persons whatsoever In testimony whereof  
 we hereunto set our hands and seals the day & date first above written
