The following Deed of Conveyance from William Simpson to Hugh Roark being proven before Sept Carter by the oath of Joseph Ayres was presented and recorded this 6th day of June 1797

The State of South Carolina, Know all men by these presents that I William Simson of Greenville County and State of South Carolina Saddle in consideration of fifty pounds Sterling money to me paid by Hugh Roark of the County aforesaid. I have granted bargained & sold, and by these presents doth release and demiss, and do grant bargain and sell unto the said Hugh Roark all that plantation or parcel of land containing thirty six acres be the same more or less lying and being in Greenville County on the waters of Ready River beginning Beginning on a red oak Mosley's corner on the East side of the big Road, thence running to a spanish oak on Loughridges line, thence along Loughridges line to a corner black oak near the grove Road, thence up the grove Road to the beginning red oak it being a part of a tract of land Originally granted to William Kainer by the said William Moultrie Governor for that time appointed
