

The following deed of Conveyance from William Bledsoe to William Thompson being proven before Robert M. Case Esq^r by the oath of Gibson Southern was presented and recorded this 14th day of June 1797

This Indenture made the thirtieth day of December in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety six and in the twenty first year of the Independency of the United States of America between William Bledsoe of the State of South Carolina and Greenville County of the one part and William Thompson of the County State aforesaid of the other part Witnesseth that the said William Bledsoe for and in consideration of the sum of seventy pounds sterling money to him in hand well and Truly paid by the said William Thompson at or before the sealing & delivering of these presents the receipt whereof the said William Bledsoe doth hereby acknowledge he the said William Bledsoe hath granted bargained and sold aliened and confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain & sell and confirm unto the said William Thompson his heirs and assigns for ever a certain Tract of Land containing one hundred and fifty acres more or less being part of a tract granted to Uriah Coner by his Excellency William Mowbray Esq^r situate in Greenville County south side of Emure River begining on a Hickree on Nempes branch running up said Branch bounded with land laid out for George Russell cornering again on a Black oak running up a little branch to a Stake, thence running a souer west course to a Hickree, thence running a south course to a poplar Corner on the mery branch thence down said mery branch to where it enters into the Cane Brake branch thence the various courses of the branch down to a dogwood corner, thence a west course to a Black oak corner, thence a north course to a pine from the pine corne to a little branch up s^d branch to a maple corner from thence to a white oak Stake from thence to said begining corner on a Hickree it being part of a Tract of Land granted to s^d Conner of nine hundred & twenty nine acres lying on said Cane brake branch reference being therunto had may more fully appear together with all trees, wood under woods with common and commons water and water courses whatsoever to the said Tract belong or in any wise appertaining and also the reversion and reversions remainder and remainders rents and services of the said premises and of every part thereof and also all rights titles Interest claim or demand of him the said William Bledsoe or his heirs or assigns the said Tract of land containing one hundred and fifty acres more or less and every part and parcel thereof to have and to hold all and singular the premises above mentioned unto the said William Thompson and his heirs for ever & said William Bledsoe for himself and his heirs the said Tract with the appurtenances thereof against him and his heirs and all other persons for ever to the said William Thompson his heirs and assigns well warrant and defend to the s^d Thompson by these presents In witness whereof the s^d William Bledsoe hath hereunto set his hand & Seal the day & date above written
