and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell & release unto the
said George Allin a plantation or Tract of land laying and being in Greenville
County on the waters of South Sagar river beginning at a post oak & running thence
N^o 55 E^o 34 ch^o to a pine (widow Smiths line) thence with her line N^o 69 ch^o to
a stake, thence S^o 75 W^o 47 ch^o to a pine, thence S^o 15 E^o 9 ch^o to a stake (on Nelsons
line) thence with his line E^o 15 ch^o to a stake his corner, thence S^o to the begin-
ing containing by estimation two hundred and Twenty two acres to the
same more or less the same being part of a Tract of land granted to me
by patent bearing date 5th day of June 1786 including the Improvement
made by Joshua King & Charles Angle Together with all and singular the
rights members here dibraments & appurtenances to the said premises
belonging or in any wise appertaining to have and to hold all and
