I know all men by these presents that I John Rodgers of S. Carolina and County of Greenville for and in consideration of the sum of Eighty Dollars to me in hand paid by Horatia Griffin of said State & County the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge have bargained sold and delivered and by these presents both bargain sell and deliver unto the said H. Griffin one set of Blacksmiths Tools, three feather Beds with furniture with several other articles of House hold furniture to have & to hold the above mentioned property to the said H. Griffin his heirs or assigns for ever, and I the said John Rodgers for myself my heirs Executors Administrators and assigns against all and every person or persons shall and will warrant and for ever defend by these presents in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this 12<sup>th</sup> day of July 1797.
