The following deed of Conveyance from William Tabb to Martha Langford being proven before Reuben Barnett Esq^r by the oath of William Whitehead was presented and Recorded this 22nd January 1798 State of South Carolina Know all men by these presents that William Tabb Sen^r of Greenville County and State aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred pounds to me paid by Martha Langford of the State and County aforesaid have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Martha Langford a tract or parcel of land containing two hundred and Twenty acres more or less situate in Greenville County on both sides of the long branch of Tygar River beginning on a pine Robert Nelsons corner, running thence North forty degrees East fifty one chains with said Nelsons line to a post oak, thence East Eleven chain to a white on the East bank of Tygar River, thence North thirty seven degrees west forty chains to a hickory on or near Howards line, thence South forty three degrees Twenty chain to a post oak, thence South Eighty six degrees west thirty chains to a Red oak, thence along a conditional line to the mouth of a small branch that runs into the long branch on the South side, thence up the said small branch to Jeremiah Tabbs line, thence along said line to the beginning together with all and singular the rights members her appurtenances and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Martha Langford her heirs and assigns for ever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and Administrators to warrant and for ever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Martha Langford her heirs and assigns against myself and my heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof witness my hand and seal this fourteenth day of July one thousand seven hundred and ninety seven
