Richard Brasel for and in consideration of the sum of thirty five pounds Sterling money to him in hand paid by the s^d. Samuel Bowen the receipt whereof he the s^d. Brasel hath granted sold alienated released conveyed and confirmed and doth by these presents both bargain sell assign and release convey and confirm unto the s^d. Samuel Bowen his heirs and assigns for ever in his actual possession being now a certain tract of land containing one hundred and Twenty one acres situated being and lying on the South side of Clear Creek of Tyggar River beginning on the South side of s^d. Clear creek running all along the old line from the Creek to a red oak Saplin for a corner thence fifty five west to the corner, thence along the said line to the creek and down the s^d. Creek to the beginning it being measured is one hundred and Twenty one acres it being a tract of land granted to s^d. Brasel on the seventh day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and eighty seven s^d. Grant with the plat being duly recorded in the Secretaries Office of s^d. State reference being thereunto will more fully appear bound on William Mory and Daniel Belleys land together & single the houses and out Houses woods & under woods ways water paths ways & appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining and also the reversion and every part thereof with every appurtenance thereof and every right title & claim & demand whatsoever of him the s^d. Richard Brasel of in one hundred and Twenty one acres of land above s^d. mentioned to have and to hold the s^d. Tract of & all and single the premises above mentioned & every part thereof with every appurtenance unto the s^d. Samuel Bowen his heirs & assigns to the proper use and behoof of him the s^d. Samuel Bowen his heirs & assigns for ever, and the s^d. Richard Brasel for himself & his heirs the said one hundred and Twenty one acres & its premises and every part thereof against him & his heirs & assigns of all and every other person or persons whatsoever to the s^d. Samuel Bowen to his heirs and assigns shall and will for ever warrant and for ever defend by these presents in witness whereunto s^d.
