The following Deed of Conveyance from George Brasel to  
 David Hall being proven before ~~the~~ William Anderson Esq<sup>r</sup> by the  
 oath of James Brantley Esq<sup>r</sup> was presented and Recorded this 6<sup>th</sup> Day of April 1798  
 This Indenture made this thirteenth Day of January and in the year of  
 our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety five and in the nine  
 tenth year of a ~~un~~ American independency between George Brasel  
 of the County of Greenville and State of South Carolina in Washington  
 District of the one part and David Hall of the same County and State  
 and District aforesaid of the other part witnesseth that the said  
 George Brasel for and in the consideration of the sum of thirty pounds  
 Sterling money to him in hand paid by the said David Hall the  
 the receipt whereof he the said Brasel doth acknowledge him-  
 self fully satisfied and paid by these presents hath given granted  
 bargained and sold <sup>and</sup> sole <sup>and</sup> conveyed in fee simple Conveyed and confirmed unto  
 him the said David Hall a certain tract or parcel of Land contain-  
 ing sixty five acres lying and being in the County and State aforesaid  
 Situation both Sides of Carters fork of Tyger River patented by Benjamin  
 Burton bearing date 1789 and from him conveyed by deed to  
 George Brasel and now from Brasel to Hall bounded as follows it begin-  
 ning at a pile of Rock and Shuns thence crossing a flat Rock  
 N 50° E 47 Chains and 80 Link to a Large Red oak by thence  
 S 63° E 45 Chains and 50 Link to a Laurel Ox thence S 33° W  
 43 Chains and 30 Link to an <sup>up</sup> parish oak by thence S 38° E 66 Chains  
 and 50 Links crossing the Sunday path to a poplar thence
