Whereas at a Court held in the County
of Greenville before the Judges of the said County
in February Term in the year of Our Lord 1795.

Mary Barry was tried for Bastardy, found guilty
and fined in the sum of five Pounds Sterling: Now know
Ye that for divers good Causes & Considerations in hereto
moving. I have thought fit to remit & Release, & by this
Present do Remit and release the said Mary Barry
from the Fine aforesaid, of which all concerned are
to take due Notice, & govern themselves according to Law
