1787\* Together with all and singular the rights members Heri-  
taments and appurtenances to the said Premises belonging  
or in any wise incident Or appertaining: To Have and to  
hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto  
the said David Goodtell his Heirs and assigns for ever and  
I do here by bind myself, my heirs executors and administra-  
tors to warrant and forever defend all and singular the  
said Premises unto the said David Goodtell his Heirs &  
and assigns against myself and my Heirs, and against  
every Person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim  
the same or any part thereof —
