


20 of Greenville and State of South Carolina of the one part and William Ferguson of the aforesaid County and State of the Other part witnesseth that the said Eli Norman for and Inconsideration of the sum of fifty Pounds Sterling money to him in hand Paid by the said William Ferguson the Receipt and payment whereof is here by acknowledged by the said Eli Norman hath bargained and sold and by these presents doth bargain and sell unto the said William Ferguson a plantation or Tract of Land containing one hundred acres lying and being in Greenville County on the waters of Brush Creek Beginning on a red Oak and running N^o 20 E, 27 to a Post Oak thence N^o 70 W 50 to a Stake thence S^o 30 to a Sassafras from thence to the beginning which said Tract of Land of one hundred acres with all and Every of its appertinances the said Eli Norman doth from himself, and his Heirs and from all and Every Other Person and Persons well warrant and for ever defend to the said William Ferguson his Heirs and assigns for ever in full strength whereof the said Eli Norman hath here unto set his hand and affixed his Seal the day and year above Written
