 County of Greenville on Elisha Thompson all of
~~tract of Land lying~~ Beaver dam creek Beginning
 on a Poplar Station near a branch & Running
 thence S^o 60^o W to a red Oak thence S^o 30^o W 31-
 1/2^o Acs & 50^o S^o E to a Red Oak thence S^o 58^o
 20^o Acs to a stake thence N^o 75^o E to Beaver dam
 creek thence down the Meanders of said Creek
 to the mouth of the first branch on the S^o side of said
 Creek thence up of meanders of S^d branch to of beginning
 containing One hundred and Forty acres be the same
 more or less the same being part of a tract of Land
 Granted by Patton to James Maxwell bearing date
 of 7th day of April 1788 Together with all &
 singular of rights manners tenements &
 and appurtenances to of said Premises belonging
 or in any wise appertaining To have and to hold all
 & singular the premises before mentioned unto the
 said John Thomas his heirs & assigns forever & do hereby
 bind my self my heirs Executors & administrators
