State of S^c Carolina — Know all men
by these Presents that I Thomas Kuse of Spartan-
burgh County in consideration of the sum
of Two hundred Dollars to me paid by David
Kuddleston of the County of Greenville
have Granted bargained sold and released and
by these presents do grant bargain sell and
release unto the said David Kuddleston a
plantation or parcel of Land laying &
being in the County of Greenville on the waters
of S^c Laureate River (on the N side of the same)
beginning at a Red Oak corner on the side of
the S^d Kuddlestons spring branch thence S^o 73^o W^o
25^o ch^o to a post Oak thence S^o 81^o W^o 27^o ch^o
20 L^o to a chinout thence N^o 35^o W^o ch^o
to a spanish Oak thence S^o 07^o E^o 25^o ch^o to a
pine sapling thence N^o 81^o E^o 11 ch^o to a pine
thence N^o 50^o E^o 31 ch^o 50 L^o to a Red Oak
thence S^o 20^o E^o 13 ch^o 50 L^o to a Post Oak
thence E^o 10 ch^o to a Post Oak thence S^o 88^o
8 ch^o to a Post Oak thence S^o 58^o W^o 10 ch^o
to a Red Oak on the bank of a little Creek
thence down the several windings of the Creek
