

The following deed of conveyance from Epaphroditus
 Hightower to John Hightower being proven before
 Robert Cook Esq by the oath of Jeremiah Godwin
 was presented and recorded this 3rd day of Feb'y 1801

This Indenture made this thirteenth day of November
 One thousand seven hundred and ninety nine between
 Epaphroditus Hightower of the County of Greenville
 and State of S Carolina of the first part and John
 Hightower of the state and County aforesaid of the second
 part witnesseth that the said John Hightower for
 and in consideration sum of Two hundred and Eighty dollars
 to him in hand paid at or before the sealing and deliv-
 ering of these presents and the receipt whereof he
 has hereby acknowledged hath given granted bargained
 and sold and by these presents doth give grant bargain
 and sell release and release convey and confirm unto the
 said John Hightower his heirs and assigns forever a
 certain tract or parcel of Land situate lying and
 being in said State and County above written on both sides
 of the beaver dam creek part of a survey originally
 granted to Joseph Caughen hath such boundaries as
 follows Viz, beginning on the N side of said Creek on a
 red oak corner on the short branch thence S. W. straight
 line to Ralph Smiths line thence along the said line crossing
 the said Creek three times by the cross of the creek to a
 dead maple corner thence S. E. straight line to a red oak
