Know all men by these presents that I Thomas Maxwell of the State of Tennessee late of S^t Carolina Greenville District for & in consideration of the sum of Three hundred Dollars to me in hand paid by Nimmerod Maxwell of the State S.C before mentioned have Granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell & release unto the said Nimmerod Maxwell a plantation or tract of land laying and being in the state aforesaid and District of Greenville on both sides of Green's Creek of S^t Pacolet River near the Hog back mountain covering lands laid out for Duncan Campbell & others Beginning at a post oak & a stake running thence $4^{\circ} 43' W$ 33 chs to a chestnut thence $1^{\circ} 35' E$ 50 chs to a red oak thence $1^{\circ} 55' W$ 20 chs to a Hickory thence $1^{\circ} 30' E$ 17 chs 50 lds to a chestnut thence N , $60'$, E , 28 chs to a large chestnut thence N , $26'$, W , 12 chs to a white oak thence N , $28'$, E 18 chs to a chestnut thence N , 20 chs to a stake thence N , $45'$, W 30 chs to the beginning containing by estimation Two hundred and five acres the same being Granted to me by patent bearing date April 7th 1788 and wherein John Roberts now lives Together with all and singular the rights numbers & incumbrances and appertaining
