

 have granted bargained sold and released &
 by these presents do bargain sell and release unto
 the said Martin Gollonhan part of a tract of
 Land Originally granted to me for three hundred &
 Thirty acres Sign^d by William Montree by a grant
 bearing date the fifth day of June 1786 now
 from the said Abner Bushop to the said Martin
 Gollonhan part of the said tract the north end
 of said tract beginning at a post oak on the old
 line running N 60 W 22 ch 50 Lk to a post
