John Adlon being proven before Thomas Edwards  
Esq. by the oath of Henry Chamblis was presented  
and recorded this 27<sup>th</sup> day of Feb: 1807. —  
This Indenture made this the Twentysixth day of  
December in the year of our Lord One thousand seven  
hundred and nine by me between John Champion  
of the County of Greenville & State of Carolina of  
the one part & John Adlon of the County and State afo-  
said of the other part witnesseth that the said John  
Campbell for and in consideration of the sum Twenty  
three pounds Sterling money to him in hand paid by the  
said John Adlon the receipt whereof is here by acknow-  
ledged by the said John Campbell hath bargained and  
sold and by these presents doth bargain and sell  
unto the said John Adlon a certain tract of land  
lying and being in Greenville County on the waters  
Brushy Creek containing Two hundred acres of land  
more or less to being a part of a tract of land
