 doth bargain and sell unto the said James Taylor  
 a certain tract or parcel of land lying in Granville  
 County on both sides of Mountain Creek beginning  
 on a black gum thence an East course to a chesnut  
 thence from the chesnut to the Creek thence down  
 the Creek to a low sides line thence along the said  
 line to a black oak corner thence a straight  
 line to the Creek thence running down the Creek to
