The following deed of Conveyance from Pleasant Sullivan to James Abercrombie being presented to H. Cobb Esqr by the oath of ^{Wm} Prof was presented and recorded this 5 day of march 1801—

State of Carolina Greenville County— Know all men by these presents that I Pleasant Sullivan of the State and County aforesaid do in consideration of the sum of fifty five dollars to me paid by James Abercrombie of this state aforesaid and County of Laurens have granted bargain sold and conveyed and by these presents do grant bargain sell and convey unto the said James Abercrombie all that tract or parcel of land containing containing one hundred and six acres more or less lying and being in Greenville County on the waters of head of Rudy river joining as bounding as follows (to wit) beginning on a pine stump running thence N 85 1/2 E 43- One half tons land to a pine stump thence S 4 23- 53 On to Prof's land to a stake 34 thence N 43- 10 on Dabrumble's land to a stake 34 thence S 10 to a Post oak 34 thence 4 1/2- 96 to land in line
