Carter being proven before John Thomas Jun^r Esq^r by the oath of
Wm^r D Thomas was presented and recorded this 10th day of March 1807
State of Carolina — Know all men by these presents
that I Henry Pearson of the state and district aforesaid
and in consideration of the sum of six hundred dollars
to me in hand paid by Robert Carter of the said District
the said Henry Pearson have granted bargained sold &
released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and
release unto the said Robert Carter all that tract
plantation and parcel of land containing Two hundred
acres situate on Childers beaver dam a branch of South
fork of Tygar River beginning on a pine stump 50^{ft}
50 chains to a white oak stump N^o 34 W ⁴⁰ chains to a
red oak Chilaryss line tree stump N^o 6 E ⁸ with the
mark^d line to a spring branch running out of the land
thence to a stake on the bank of beaver dam creek this line
