Know all men by these presents that I George Dalrymple
of the State aforesaid and County of Laurens do
in consideration of the sum of One hundred and
Twenty five silver dollars to me paid by Gartant
Floyd of the State aforesaid & County of Greenville have
granted bargained sold and released and by these presents
do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Gartant
Floyd all that tract or parcel of land containing one
hundred and thirty acres more or less beginning on a
Stake 37 thence N 39^o 00' land unknown to a
to a W 37 thence west 39^o 40' on land formerly
belonging to Peter Puck to a S 37 thence
South 39^o 00' on beals land to a Stake 37 thence
E 39^o 40' on Pleasant Sulphur land to the
beginning corner including one hundred and thirty
acres of land more or less Together with all and
singular the rights members Accoutments &
and appertenance to the said premises belonging
or in any wise incident or appertaining to have and
to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned
