singular the rights members hereditaments and
appertinances whatsoever thereunto belonging
or in any wise incident or appertaining to have
& to hold all and singular the premises before men-
tioned to the said Baylis Earle his heirs & assigns
forever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors
and administrators to warrant and forever defend
the same unto the said Baylis Earle his his heirs &
assigns against myself & my heirs & against every
other person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to
claim the same or any part thereof Witness my
