

207 east side of Ruddy river being parts of four separate surveys to wit one hundred and sixty acres being a part of two surveys one to Fred^l Hawkins & one to Ann Casby beginning at Ruddy River on Charles line thence north 11 East 24 chains to said Charles Stake Corner thence south 46 East 35 ch along said Charles line to Hawkins line thence north 22 East 5-50 to red oak thence north 68 West eighty seven chains & 90 links to a sour wood near the bank of the river being an old corner thence down the meanders of the river to the beginning which said land was conveyed from Fred^l Hawkins & Anne Casby to the said Baylis Earle as may appear by referring to these conveyances on record. Also two hundred and sixteen acres being a part of two other surveys one to Baylis Earle senior & one to William Giles. Beginning on a small post oak being Tho^s Edwards & John M.
