Esq^r by the oath of Albert Robins was presented and
recorded this 2nd day of July 1807

State of Carolina — Know all men by these presents
that Thomas Jenkins of the State aforesaid and
Greenville District in consideration of four hundred
dollars to me paid by James Harrison of said State and
District have granted bargain sold and released and by
these presents do bargain sold and release, and by these
presents do bargain sell and release unto the him
the said James Harrison, all that tract of land lying
in the District aforesaid and on both sides of Needy river
originally granted to John Ford for two hundred acres of
land sign^d by Governor Guignard on the twenty first day
of Jan^y One thousand seven hundred and eighty five
beginning on a red oak thence N W 65^o 44 chain and
seventy two links to a blackory corner thence S E 6^o 25^o
forty four chain & seventy two links to a white oak corner
thence S W 25^o forty four chain & seventy two links crossing
the said river to the beginning also part of one other tract
of land bounded by the land of Thomas Terry on the south
and south west and the above tract of land on the
North and north east containing by estimation fifty
acres be the same more or less Together with all and
singular the rights members hereditaments and
