

240 The following deed of Conveyance from James Knoll to Hardy  
Forester being proven before Reuben Barnett Esq by the oath of John  
Mansford was presented and recorded this 15<sup>th</sup> July 1804  
Know all men by these presents that James Knoll of the  
State of South Carolina, Greenville District for and in con-  
sideration of the sum of One hundred dollars well and truly paid  
before the delivering of these presents to me by Hardy Forester  
and by these presents have bargained sold released and conveyed  
and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release convey &  
confirm unto Hardy Forester of the District aforesaid One  
hundred acres of land more or less it being parts of eight  
hundred and sixty four acres of land granted for John Knoll  
the 14<sup>th</sup> Day of November seventeen hundred and eighty seven  
situate in the District of ninety six on one branch of the  
meadow Fork and other branch of the Musk Creek of South  
Tiger river beginning on a maple in the branch on John  
Bradley's line thence W to a chestnut Oak Corner thence  
running E to a Hickory Corner on the south side of the  
mountain thence takes over the mountain the north side  
along Richard Forester's line to a red Oak Corner thence thence  
along his line to the beginning corner together with all woods  
water courses Orchards gardens houses Tenes and all the  
improvements thereon to have and to hold all the said bargain-  
ed premises unto the said Hardy Forester his heirs and assigns  
forever to enjoy peacefully possess said land and premises with all  
and every part thereof from & to James Knoll his heirs  
administrators and assigns forever and he the said Hardy Forester  
his heirs be it as adm<sup>r</sup> and assigns to hold the said land and pre-  
mises free from from all persons or persons whatsoever having  
title or claim thereunto Truly in witness whereof I the said  
James Knoll have hereunto set my hand and affixed
