The following deed of conveyance from Wm. Shroud to Thomas
Barton being proven before Neulin Bault Esq. by the oath of Da-
vid Barton was presented and recorded this 21st day of July 1801
South Carolina - Know all men by these presents
that I Wm. Shroud of the State of South Carolina District of Green-
ville in consideration of the sum of one hundred and
twenty five Dollars to me paid by Thomas Barton
Jun^r of the District aforesaid I have granted bargain
sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain
sell and release unto the said Tho. Barton Jun^r a Plan-
tation or tract of land lying and being in Greenville
District on the waters of Tiger river on the north
fork of the South fork of said being part of a tract
of land granted to John Justice Jun^r beginning on
a Spanish Oak corner of the said tract of land running
S. 65° E 50-25 to a chestnut corner thence S 25° E 29
to a stake for a corner thence S 65° W 30-50 thence across
the said land by a conditional line to a white oak station
on the other line the conditional line to be straight
thence to the afore Spanish Oak corner containing
by estimation one hundred acres more or less the same being
part of a tract of land granted to John Justice Jun^r
by patent bearing date the fourth day of September in the
year of 1786 and by the said Justice sold and conveyed unto the
said Wm. Shroud and by me the said Wm. Shroud sold unto
