

293 The following deed of conveyance from Isaac Gray to John Burns being proven before D. Hudson Esq^r by the oath of John Hammett was presented and recorded this 6th day of October 1801

This Indenture made the second day of March A^D 1801 & in the 25th year of the Independence of America between Isaac Gray of South Carolina Greenville District of the one part and John Burns of ^{S^C} State and District of the other part witnesseth that the said Isaac Gray for and in consideration of the sum of eight hundred Dollars to him in hand well and truly paid by the said John Burns at or before the sealing and delivering of these presents the receipt hereof the said Isaac Gray doth hereby acknowledge he the said Isaac Gray hath granted bargain ed and sold aliened and confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain sell alien and confirm unto the said John Burns his heirs and assigns forever a certain tract of land containing one hundred and ninety five acres of land be the same more or less it being a part of a tract of land of five hundred and eighty seven acres Granted to Edward Balingen by his Excellency William Moultrie Governor & Commander in Chief in and over the said State situate on Enore River above the Indian boundary beginning at the beginning corner of said Tract on a hickory tree running with said line to a black oak the said being a corner of Henry Melham land then with the said Melham's line across Enore to Hickory corner on South side of s^r river then up the river to and oak corner of Stephen Cantrells land then across the river at a little Shoal with a straight with Cantrells line to a stake at the head of a small branch on said Balingens line and Mazing line then
