This Indenture made this nineteenth day of November in the year of our Lord One thousand Seven hundred and ninety nine between Leonard Clayborne of the State of South Carolina Greenville County of the One part, and Solomon Forester and a Spartanburgh County of the other part, Witnesseth that the said Leonard Clayborne for & in consideration of the sum of Forty pounds Sterling to him in hand paid the Receipt whereof he doth hereby acknowledge, hath bargained granted and sold and by these presents doth bargain grant sell and confirm unto the said Solomon Forester a certain Plantation or Part of Land containing or supposed to be One Hundred Acres it being Part of a tract of Land granted from States Office to La^d Forester bearing date One thousand seven hundred & eighty seven lying and being in Spartanburgh County & State afores^d and Situate on a branch of Little back Creek, beginning at a pine, running thence S 36 W. to a Red Oak thence N 45 W. 50 to a Red Oak, thence N 45 E. 15 to a Red Oak
