This Indenture made this fourteenth day of October one thousand eight hundred and one between Jacob Swofford of Greenville District & State of S<sup>c</sup> Carolina of one part, and Thomas Howard of the District afores<sup>d</sup> the other part — Witnesseth that the s<sup>d</sup> Jacob Swofford for and in consideration of the sum of twenty dollars to him in hand paid by the s<sup>d</sup> Thomas Howard the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged the s<sup>d</sup> Jacob Swofford hath sold convey<sup>d</sup> & confirmed & by these presents doth grant convey & confirm unto the s<sup>d</sup> Thomas Howard part of a Tract of Land granted to the s<sup>d</sup> Jacob Swofford on the fifth of February one thousand seven hundred & ninety eight Situate in Greenville District on the South side of Tyger River, beginning at Peter Howard's Corner on a post and running on the s<sup>d</sup> Howard's line to a stake, thence on a Condit<sup>ional</sup> line to a stake on the Widow Langford's line, thence to the beginning Containing twenty acres more or less, now by these Presents by the s<sup>d</sup> Jacob Swofford, unto the s<sup>d</sup> Thomas Howard, Together with all & singular all rights houses Privileges wood timber waters and hereditaments & appurtenances hereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining to the s<sup>d</sup> Howard to have and to hold all the above mentioned
