


State of South Carolina Greenville County. - For & in consideration of the sum of twenty pounds current money to him in hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, he the said Michael Henderson hath granted bargained sold & released, and by these Presents doth grant bargain sell and release unto Mark Davis his heirs &c. a piece of Land containing fifty acres more or less lying & situate in the County aforesaid on the Waters of Mountain Creek beginning at the Mouth of the Long branch thence N.E. 75. 30 Ch. to a Stake Corner thence due North a Considerable distance to Charles Ester Spring branch, thence by a Stake few poles up s^d branch to the Mouth of a hollow, thence up s^d Hollow along Chas^r Ester line to said Youngs old field, thence along the fence to the opposite Corner thence to the head of a Spring branch, thence down the same to a marked poplar, thence along Chas^r Ester line to the long branch thence down s^d branch to the beginning, together with all & singular the Premises hereintments, appurtenances above mentioned or any part thereof or in any wise appertaining, also the Reversion & Reversions &c. - mainder & Remainders, Rents Issues and Services of the s^d Premises & also all the Estate Right Title, claim & demand whatsoever of him the s^d Michael Henderson in & to the s^d Land or any Part thereof, to have & to hold the s^d Land to the s^d Mark Davis and his heirs for ever, and the s^d Michael Henderson for himself and his heirs the s^d Land and Premises against him & his heirs & every other person shall Warrant & am for ever defend by these presents - In Witness whereof the said Michael Henderson hath set his hand & seal this twelfth day of September one thousand eight hundred & one in the twenty Eighth y^r of American Independence -
