 s^d John Daves and his heirs and assigns a certain piece or tract of land
 granted to the s^d Peck Situate lying and being on each side of the
 old Indian boundaries, and on each of Gilews creek in Greenville
 County, & bounded as follows beginning at a Post Oak tree and running
 N. 12 E. 50. amop Gilews creek to Stake Corner bounding on vacant Land
 thence N. 60 W. 33 to a pine Corner bounding on vacant Land, thence running
 S 40 W. 13. 58. to a pine Corner bounding on vacant land, thence running S 15. W.
 32, 50. to a Post Oak corner thence running S 15 E. 13, 4 to a Stake Corn^r.
 bounding on vacant Land, thence running S 72 E. 38, 50 to a Post Oak
 Corner which is the beginning Corner, & bounding on vacant Land the s^d Tract of
 Land containing two Hundred Acres more or less, and all houses buildings
 watercourses Orchard & improvements & appurtenances whatsoever belong
 to the s^d granted premises, and all Estate Right title Use & Interest
 of him the said John Peck his heirs and assigns of him & to the said
