assigns a certain tract or parcel of land containing twenty
acres in the same more or less situate in Greenville District
aforesaid on a branch of the north fork of Saluda river
including the improvement known by the name of Tannah
of old store and runs as follows (that is to say) beginning
on a hickory tree along a marked line to a red oak
thence along a marked line to a dog wood, thence along
a marked line to a hickory tree along a marked
line to the beginning, together with all & singular the
woods waters watercourses buildings improvements fixtures
and appurtenances herunto belonging or in any
wise incident or appertaining to have and to hold all
and singular the premises before mentioned unto the
J^d Elias Earle his heirs or assigns for ever and I do
hereby bind myself my heirs and executors & adm^t to
to warrant and for ever defend all and singular
the said premises unto Elias Earle his Heirs & assigns
against myself my heirs & against all & every
other person or persons whomsoever claiming or to
claim the same or any part thereof, In witness
