released and by these presents do grant bargain sell  
and release unto the said Elias Earle his heirs and  
assigns a Certain Tract or parcel of Land Containing twenty  
acres be the same more or less Situate in Greenville District  
aforesaid on a branch of the north fork of Saluda river  
Including the improvement known by the name of Tarants  
of old Stone and runs as follows (that is to say) beginning  
on a Hickory thence along a marked line to a red oak  
thence along a marked line to a dog wood, thence along  
a marked line to a hickory thence along a marked  
line to the beginning, Together with all & Singular the  
woods waters Watercourses Buildings Profits Herita-  
ments and appertanances herunto belonging or in any  
wise Incident or appertaining to have and to hold all  
and Singular the premises before mentioned unto the  
S<sup>r</sup> Elias Earle his heirs or assigns for ever and I do  
hereby bind myself my heirs and Executors & adm<sup>r</sup>. to  
to warrant and for ever defend all and Singular  
the said premises unto Elias Earle his heirs & assigns  
against myself my heirs & against all & Every  
other person or persons whomsoever Claiming or to  
claim the same or any part thereof In Witness  
whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my  
Seal this Thirtieth day of November in the year  
of our Lord one Thousand Eight Hundred Four
