 or near the head of a branch thence down the said branch to
 Elijah Kilcrease line thence said Kilcrease line to the beginning
 Together with all and singular rights members hereditaments
 and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any
 wise incident or appertaining To have and to hold all &
 singular the said premises before mentioned unto the said
 Thomas Kilcrease his heirs and assigns for Ever and I do
 hereby bind myself heirs Executors & administrators to warrant
 and for Ever defend all and singular the said premises unto
 the said Thomas Kilcrease his heirs or assigns against myself
 and my heirs and against all and every other person or persons
 whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any
