of said Creek to a Forked Hickory Corner, now, on the Bank of ^{the} Creek
 thence on a marked line S 75 E 1/4; 3/4 to a Small Maple Corner
 on the Bank of S^d Creek, again thence down the Meander of S^d
 Creek to where the Original line crosses S^d Creek thence on a S.
 line N. 10. E. 9. 50 to a Black Oak Corner old, thence on the Ori-
 ginal line N 80 W. 50 Ch. to the beginning Red Oak Corner which
 includes the full land to be conveyed. Together with all appur-
 tenances the rights, tenements hereditaments and appurtenances to
 the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or con-
 taining. To have and to hold all & singular the premises here-
 fore mentioned unto the said George Lewis his heirs & assigns
 forever. And I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and
 Administrators, to warrant and defend all things relating
 to the said premises unto the said George Lewis his heirs & assigns
 against myself and my heirs and against every person who shall
 ever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
