Know all men by these presents that I John ~~James~~ Goode of the State of South Carolina and County of Greenville for and in consideration of the sum of five shillings Sterling to me in hand paid by John Jones of the County & State aforesaid Have granted bargain sold and release and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said John Jones that part or parcel of land containing twenty acres be the same more or less situate on the waters of the South fork of Saluda river beginning on a post oak on the dividing line between the s^d Goode & Jones thence to the head of William Grants Spring branch thence down the branch to a White Oak support to be in the old line thence S 6 W. to a black gum thence S 3 E. to a Stake thence N 88 E. to the beginning together with all & singular the rights members hereditaments & appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining To have and to hold all and singular the Premises before mentioned unto the said John Jones his heirs & assigns forever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Exors & Adm^{rs} to warrant and for ever defend all & singular the said premises unto the said John Jones his heirs & assigns against myself & my heirs &
