Know all men by these presents that I Benjamin Kilgore Sheriff of Greenville District in the State aforesaid for and in consideration of fifty pounds to me in hand paid by William Johnston of the State and a trust aforesaid I the said Benjamin Kilgore Sheriff have granted bargain sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said William Johnston All that Tract or parcel of Land Containing one hundred and forty three acres Situate on the S^d Side of Gilchus Creek waters of Ennore River in the State and District aforesaid the same being a part of 640 acres originally granted to W^m. Marchbanks the balance originally granted to John Carmichael the land to be Conveyed begins (as follows Viz) on a pine corner on Sadlers Fences line and runs on said line N 35 E. 63 chains to a Stone Corner thence S 12 W. 16 Ch. to a Dogwood corner thence S 27 W. 7.75 to a purple corner on the bank of a small branch thence down S. Branch to a Black Gum corner thence N. 79. W. 24 Ch. to a Gum corner, on the bank of the long branch thence up said branch to a White Oak corner on S^d Carmichals line, thence on S^d S 30 E. 8. C 50 to a Stake corner old, made for said Tract, thence on S^d line N. 60 E. 31. 62 to an ash corner, thence on S. Marchbanks line S 30 E. 14. 50 to a stump corner, thence N. 60 E. 20 Ch. to Hannahs Johnsons Black Oak corner, thence on his line S 6 E. 39. 80 to a Hickory corner thence N 60 E. 34 Ch. to a Red Oak corner, thence N 15. W. 10. 85. to the beginning pine corner. Johnston his heirs Ex^{rs} adm^{rs} & assigns forever. against myself my heirs Ex^{rs} & adm^{rs} against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
