Adm^rs & Assigns for ever and I the said Thomas Goin for myself my Executors & Adm^rs the said hereby bargained premises unto the s^d William Young his Exec^{rs}. Adm^rs & Assigns against all persons shall & well warrant & for ever defend by these Presents — In Witness whereof I the s^d Thomas Goin have here unto set my hand & Seal this 22nd day of February Eighteen hundred & two —
